



In the bottom right hand corner of your desktop, click on sounds icon and then recordings tab, select your headset for microphone.

# Record your Talk

Go to your PowerPoint presentation and under Slide Show, tick all tabs for narration, timings and media controls. Click on Record Slide show and from the beginning.








A pop up will appear and ensure both are ticked.

When ready – Start Recording
Your presentation will go full screen
and a counter will appear in top right
corner, run through your talk.
When you have finished, it will stop
presenting and you play your
presentation back, you will hear your
audio and the slides will change
accordingly.



When you are happy with your recording go to File > Save as and choose MP4 format.

Save the file in this format: Surname-Day of talk.mp4 (Example: Bennett-Wed.mp4)
